MEDIA INFORMATION

Credentials

The South Alabama Athletics Communications and Digital Media Office will issue credentials to WORKING press only. Passes for spouses, children or friends will not be issued. These credentials are non-transferable and any unauthorized use of a credential will result in the pass being immediately revoked. All credential requests should be made via e-mail to Brian Fremund no later than Tuesday of the week prior to start of the desired contest.

Weekly Press Conference

South Alabama will hold a press conference each Monday prior to a game throughout the 2021 season. Head coach Kane Wommack, coordinators Major Applewhite and Corey Batoon, and select student-athletes will be made available to the media at 12:30 pm (CT) in the team meeting room in the football field house.

Sun Belt Conference Teleconference

The Sun Belt Conference conducts a weekly teleconference with each of the 10 head coaches in the league. Coach Wommack will be available every week at 10:44 a.m. CT.

Practices

During regular game weeks, practices from Monday through Thursday will be open to the media; interviews with coaches and student-athletes will be conducted following the workout. Please contact Fremund in advance if you are interested in conducting interviews and/or attending a practice session, so an escort can be made available.

Interviews

In-person interviews with members of the coaching staff and student-athletes can be arranged by calling or e-mailing Fremund. Interviews with student-athletes MUST be arranged in advance through the Communications and Digital Media Office. Players are generally available after practice on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays, although phone interviews can also be arranged around the student-athletes' class and practice schedules. Student-athletes' phone numbers are not available under any circumstance. All phone interview requests must be made 24 hours prior.

Postgame Interviews

After a 10-minute cooling off period, requested players and coaches will be made available to members of the media. The Jaguar locker room is CLOSED both at home and on the road. Requested players and coaches will be escorted by a Communications and Digital Media staff member to the designated interview area in the northwest corner of Hancock Whitney Stadium.

For road games, USA will adhere to the home team's postgame policies and procedures.

OPENING KICK

- ▶ South returns home to play Alcorn State in its final outing prior to the start of Sun Belt Conference play.
- ▶ The Braves are the only NCAA Football Championship Sub-division program on the Jaguars' schedule this fall.
- ▶ USA has a 13-2 record against current NCAA FCS members with wins in their last six contests dating back to a victory over Gardner-Webb in the 2015 season opener.
- ▶ This marks the fourth time in the last five years that the Jags will face a Southwestern Conference opponent, having played host to Alabama A&M, Alabama State and Jackson State during the 2017-19 campaigns.
- ▶ Grambling was scheduled to be USA's first-ever opponent at Hancock Whitney Stadium on Sept. 12 last year as well, but the game was cancelled after the SWAC moved its season to the spring.
- ▶ South has claimed its last three meetings with programs from the Magnolia State and has a 5-3 mark all-time against Mississippi schools.

THE JAGS AGAINST SWAC COMPETITION

- ▶ USA is 4-0 all-time against league membership with a win over Mississippi Valley State in 2011 to go along with defeats of the three schools in the above note.
- ▶ The Jags have outscored the opposition 162-24 in those games.
- ▶ South has never scored fewer than 35 points while averaging 40.5 points per outing against SWAC schools.
- ▶ Defensively, the Jaguars have surrendered one score or less three times during that span.
- ▶ In fact, USA's last shutout came in a 45-0 victory over AAMU on Sept. 16, 2017.

NOTES FROM THE LAST SWAC MEETING

- ▶ The Jaguars defeated Jackson State in their home opener on Sept. 7, 2019.
- ▶ South's 413 rushing yards in the contest set a school record that still stands today.
- ▶ **Tra Minter** led the way with 189 yards on the ground and 275 all-purpose yards, both the second-highest totals on the school game record list.
- ▶ Current sophomore RB **Jared Wilson's** rushing yards that afternoon are still the highest of his career.
- ▶ The Jag offense also recorded season-best scoring, total offense and first down figures.
- ▶ It was also the fewest points and total yards allowed by USA that fall.

NOTES ON WOMMACK'S COACHING/PLAYING CAREER

- ▶ Wommack, 34, became the third head coach in program history and youngest at the NCAA Football Bowl Subdivision level when he was hired on Dec. 12 last year.
- ▶ He was one of five finalists for the Broyles Award, given to the top NCAA FBS assistant coach in the nation, in 2020 after helping Indiana go 6-2 overall while finishing 12th in the final Associated Press poll.
- ▶ In addition to serving as the Hoosiers' defensive coordinator — the youngest in the Power Five — the last two years, Wommack was also defensive coordinator for the Jags in 2016 and '17 as well as at Eastern Illinois for one season prior to his first stint in Mobile.
- ▶ The Jaguars allowed over 10 points fewer per outing than the previous campaign his first year on the staff, the fifth-best improvement in the NCAA FBS that fall.
- ▶ After beginning his collegiate playing career at Arkansas in 2006, Wommack was a fullback and tight end at Southern Miss for three years — helping the Golden Eagles to a postseason bowl appearance each fall — before receiving his degree from the school in 2009.

TWO FOR TWO

The Jaguars are off to their first 2-0 start since winning their opening two outings of the 2011 campaign, the last of 19 straight wins to begin the program's history. South last won three consecutive contests in 2014, when it earned four victories in a row from Sept. 27-Oct. 24.

SOPHOMORE EARNS SUN BELT SPECIAL TEAMS HONOR

PK **Diego Guajardo** accounted for nearly half the Jags' scoring output in their defeat of Bowling Green, posting 10 points after making a career-high-tying three field goals and adding an extra point **to be voted the Sun Belt Conference Special Teams Player of the Week on Monday**. His first two field goals supplied the only scoring by either team in the second quarter, cutting USA's deficit to two at the break, but it was his kick from 44 yards out as time expired that lifted the Jaguars to their first come-from-behind win in nearly three years. It was the fourth occasion since the start of last season that the sophomore has connected on multiple field goals, as he matched his previous high set in an Oct. 17 win over Texas State last fall.

SACK ATTACK

The outside linebacker duo of **CJ Rias** and **Christian Bell** combined to record all three of the Jaguars' sacks in their win over the Falcons last time out, giving the team seven in the first two outings of the year. The former became the became the first USA defender to post two sacks in a game since **Tyree Turner** did so in a win over Coastal Carolina on Nov. 23, 2018, while Bell is the first Jag to be credited with a sack in back-to-back contests since **Riley Cole** accomplished the feat on Oct. 26 and Nov. 9 in match-ups with nationally-ranked Appalachian State and Texas State the following season. South last finished with three-plus sacks in consecutive contests when it accomplished the feat in each of the first three games of the 2018 campaign.

CAREER DAYS ON DEFENSE

S **Yam Banks** posted five of his six stops in the opening half of the Jags' win at BGSU on the way to recording a career high in the category for the second straight outing. The freshman wasn't the only member of the unit to accomplish the feat, with **Chris Henderson** equaling his previous career best set against UAB last fall after finishing the contest with five tackles; in fact, this marks the first time since joining the program in 2016 that he has been credited with four or more stops in consecutive games.

ABLE AVERY

Entering the fourth quarter of last weekend's victory, **Terrion Avery** had rushed for 23 yards on 10 attempts; that's a total he would surpass in the final period prior to the Jaguars crossing midfield on their game-tying drive. On that march, the junior running back had gains of 12 and 11 yards for first downs before scoring on a 13-yard run with USA facing third-and-seven to tie the contest with less than two minutes remaining. Not only was it Avery's first touchdown since he scored in last year's opening win at Southern Mississippi, he finished with a career-best 82 rushing and 87 all-purpose yards.

FAST START FOR FRESHMAN RECEIVER

Caullin Lacy tied for game-high honors with eight receptions in the BGSU victory, ending the contest with 63 yards after his final catch of the night covered 20 yards to help the Jags convert a fourth-and-eight on the game-tying drive in the fourth quarter. With 13 receptions for 130 yards in South's first two outings of the fall, the freshman has already surpassed his output in both categories — 11 catches for 98 yards — from a year ago.

JAGUARS BY THE NUMBERS

Rushing yards allowed by the Jaguar defense in the win over the Falcons, the fourth-lowest total given up at the NCAA Football Bowl Subdivision level the first three weeks of the season. Not only was it the third-fewest yards surrendered on the ground in school history, but the least given up by USA to an NCAA FBS opponent since the program's inception in 2009.

It was just the third time in 12 occasions that the Jags have won when completing 25-plus passes in a contest.

THE NO. 5 JERSEY

On June 13, 2010, the University of South Alabama lost a member of the football program when **Anthony Mostella** passed away near his home of Oneonta, Ala.

Mostella, who would have been a senior in the fall of '10, was loved and respected by all his teammates and coaches, someone whose contributions to the program on the field were exceeded by what he was able to accomplish away from the game. Voted a team captain in the program's inaugural season, Mostella — a running back who came to South Alabama in order to continue his relationship with head coach Joey Jones — displayed his selfless nature with his contributions on special teams and in the locker room while fellow teammates racked up more yardage running the ball.

He came to USA and Mobile after playing for Jones at Birmingham-Southern in 2007, sacrificing a season of collegiate eligibility in order to help build the Jaguar program by taking part in its first-ever spring practice in March and April of 2009. During that time he would establish himself not only as a leader, but as an ambassador for the program as it established its roots in the community.

From 2010-17, the Jaguars honored Mostella each fall as one member of the senior class wore his No. 5 jersey for their final season. This fall, first-year head coach Kane Wommack is bring the tradition back with a twist, issuing the jersey to a selected member of the program each week prior to the contest.

HANCOCK WHITNEY STADIUM

The University of South Alabama Board of Trustees voted on November 10, 2018, to authorize the construction of an on-campus football stadium, paving the way for the Jaguars' first season in the new facility this fall.

The new 25,000-seat football stadium is located on the west side of campus, adjacent to the Jaguar Training Center, Football Fieldhouse and football practice fields and includes:

- Abraham A. Mitchell Field, named in recognition of a \$5 million commitment from Mitchell structured as a challenge gift — any donation to the stadium project from a minimum of \$500 to a maximum of \$250,000 per donor will be matched on a one-to-one basis — that will facilitate additional donations to Hancock Whitney Stadium
- A state-of-the-art video board — measuring 37 feet high by 100 feet wide with nearly 3,500 square feet of viewing space — and sound system
- The Michelob Ultra Terrace, named in recognition of a \$1 million gift from Budweiser-Busch Distributing Co., Inc.
- 16-seat suites, a club level with 800 seats, and premier chair-back and bench-back seating options

USA and Hancock Whitney announced on January 15, 2019, that the stadium will be named Hancock Whitney Stadium in recognition of a new, comprehensive financial partnership between the two organizations. Under the terms of the 10-year agreement, Hancock Whitney will provide the University of South Alabama with an array of financial and investment services. On September 4 last year the university made an announcement that Hargrove Engineers + Constructors committed \$1.5 million to the project and as a result the club level at the stadium will be named The Hargrove Club.

The stadium's estimated cost was \$74 million. Funding and debt service on bonded indebtedness incurred to construct the stadium will come from a combination of the athletic department, auxiliary enterprises and public/private funding. USA announced a \$2.5 million sponsorship from the Mobile County Commission, which created the Mobile County Center for Academic Success, located within the stadium's administration building behind the north end zone.

Ticket sales for Hancock Whitney Stadium began on Monday, July 8, 2019, and in just over 24 hours all suites and loges were sold out.
